HOW THE ACTIVITY WORKS

- Put students into groups of 4 or 5.
-Each group has to come up with 5 questions, to do with specific aspects that have been covered in the work on diabetes that has been done, to date.
- The question-team captain is in charge of asking the answeringteam a question.
- If the question is answered correctly, the answering-team gets IO points.
- If the answer is wrong, the answering-team gets no points and it'll be up to the question-team to provide the right answer. If the questionteam members don't know the answer to their own question, they lose 5 points.
- Scores will be recorded on the board.
- The teacher, along with any child - or children - with diabetes will be appointed joint referees.
- Should two or more teams draw level on points, it'll be the child with diabetes who gets to ask the tie-break question.
